

Lighting Design Project

You will select an instrumental track of your choosing. You will be required to write a musical description of the song and breakdown the song into units. You will provide 4-6 visuals or images from magazines or online that support your concept. After you develop the concept, you will create a lighting sheet, a cue sheet, and a GOBO (you are not completing the GOBO until the end, but make sure you keep room for it during your presentation). You will present your final project to the class with a brief description of the story followed by the lighting and musical production. Be creative with the lights!

PORTFOLIO CONTENT

1. Music description (1-2 paragraphs): What is the song you have chosen? Why did you choose it? What is the story that is being told? **(10marks)**
2. Music breakdown **(10marks)**

Example of Music Breakdown (create for the whole song)

3. Emotional Description or Story (4-6 paragraphs) **(10marks)**
4. Visual Description **(10 marks)**

Look 1	0:00 - :0012	In this look, the lights fade in and highlight the image center stage. The intensity is low (40%) and is very soft.

5. Visual support (4-6 pictures that reflect the imagery of the story. Pictures can be of colour, mood, theme, and/or imagery.). Include a BRIEF description of how the photo fits your story. **(10marks)**
6. Lighting choice – you will be required to program the submasters for your presentation **(10 marks)**

8. Complete a GOBO for your presentation. You will be designing and making a GOBO that fits with the theme/imagery/mood of your presentation. You must use the GOBO in your presentation at some point. You will hand in the original paper design. You will insert the GOBO into a light for the presentation. **(20 marks)**
9. Presentation: You must present your story with the lights and music to the class (with a brief description of the story before). **(10marks)**
