
MAJORITY VS MINORITY GOVERNMENTS

MAJORITY GOVERNMENT:

- Winning party earns OVER HALF of the seats in the House of Commons
- In Canada that means more than 154 of the 308 seats available

Example:




Conservatives form a MAJORITY Govt

MINORITY GOVERNMENT:

- Winning party earns UNDER HALF of the seats in the House of Commons
- In Canada that means less than 154 of the 308 seats available

MAJORITY GOVERNMENT:

Advantages to Canadian People:

• More seems to get done as bills can more easily be passed in the House of Commons

Disadvantages to Canadian People:

• Governing party seems to have lots of power which is not desirable to those who are not in favour of the governing party

MINORITY GOVERNMENT:

Advantages to Canadian People:

 Governing party requires support of other parties to pass legislation in the House of Commons. This can result in decisions being made that appeal to more Canadians

Disadvantages to Canadian People:

• Since passing legislation requires agreement amongst two or more parties, if parties can't agree, little legislation is passed hindering progress of Canada.
